Gases: no fixed shape, can be squashed, they expand by a varying ...

Science - States of Matter

Everything around us is matter. Everything that has a mass/volume. I can see 3 solids, liquids, gases.

Solids: candles, pebbles, computer, rock, bones, liquid nitrogen. Solids are hard and solid whereas liquids and gases are not - have a fixed shape - cannot be squashed - cannot flow.

Liquids: drinks, water, juice, saliva, petrol, liquid soap. Liquids are wet and flow whereas solids and gases are not - not a fixed shape, take the shape of what it is in - cannot be squashed - can flow.
