

Elm Class

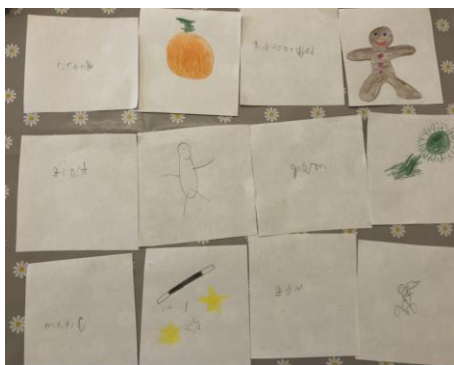


In mental maths, we have been looking at bonds to 10, 20 and 100. Children created a bonds rainbow to help them remember them.

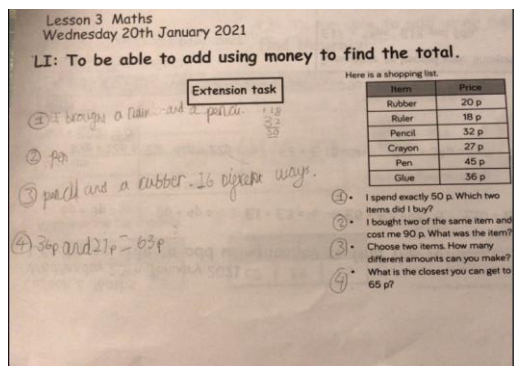
