The family will aim to:

- Ensure our child attends school regularly and on time.
- Keep contact details fully up-to-date with the school office including notifying us of any changes to home collection arrangements.
- Inform the school no later than 9.00 am on the first day our child is absent (and every day after that) and provide evidence of appointments during school time.
- Inform the school about any health issues, concerns or problems that might affect our child's work or behaviour and supply any appropriate medication or other requirements to meet these needs (e.g. asthma pumps/Epipens)
- Ensure they are properly equipped for school with book bag and PE kit bag, and appropriately dressed in school uniform as stated on the school website.
- Support our child by reading at home every day, ensuring any set homework is completed on time and giving support with home learning as needed.
- Support the school's online safety policy by ensuring that our children are not playing on age-inappropriate games or viewing other inappropriate media content.
- Take all reasonable precautions to ensure our child cannot access inappropriate materials on the internet and try to ensure that our child understands the importance of keeping all personal information secure.
- Bring to the attention of the school, and work with the school, to resolve any issues rather than discussing them on social media or by talking directly to other parents.
- Support the school's approach to pupil behaviour, anti-bullying and equality.
- Support the school's safeguarding policy. This includes informing the school if there are any concerns about the safety of any child.
- Support our child and the school by attending consultation opportunities to discuss progress and targets for improvement.
- Find out about our child's life at school (through Dojo / Class Charts) and support the school's guidelines and policies.


